Executive

- Reserve Study Recommendations due this month, next step will be to consider how to structure reserve funds over the next three years
- Update: No report from Kirk Parsons from ETC as of yet despite numerous phone calls and emails. Will continue to pursue it.
- Water Supply Estimates from Sharpe: The drain to the river continues to clog and one filter is not working. Discussion on whether to replace just the drain or also the filters.
- Replace the drain \$1675.00
- Replace 3 filters \$10,257.00.
- It was agreed upon to replace the drain this year and budget the filter (s) for next year.

Motion to have Sharp Water immediately replace the drain from the pumphouse to the marsh for the cost of \$1675 and clean the floor again. Passed unanimously.

Pumphouse will be painted a blue/gray color after drain work is done.
