In discussing the abandoned boats currently in the storage area, it came out that there are boats left there by former homeowners such as Craig Pohland. Ollie asked Mike why Pohland's boat is still there and if Pohland was being charged yearly storage fees. Mike agreed to contact Pohland and address his boat.

<u>AOB</u>: It was mentioned that three hornet's nests have been sighted under one of the pool tables as well as under the eve of the roof of the pool house. Justin will look into the issue to resolve.
